## Participate

There is strength in numbers! Join local events such as the Memory Walk, the Hunger Walk, and Warm Wishes.

## Communicate

Write letters to newspapers, your local legislators and city officials voicing your support for lasting solutions to homelessness.

## Organize a Drive

Donation drives make a difference! Socks, personal items, sleeping bags, food and other items are critically needed year round.

## Play

Host a bridge/card tournament or other event as a fundraiser for a local organization working with persons experiencing homelessness.

## Volunteer

There are many organizations in Marin that will benefit from your help throughout the year, whether it is for a one-time event or an ongoing commitment. Opportunities include volunteering at a meal site, shelter or housing program.

## Contribute

Donation drives are needed throughout the year. Many drives focus on the holidays, but essential items such as backpacks, socks, toiletries and survival items such as sleeping bags are needed year round.

## Rally

Bring friends and family members together to share a meal and discussion about how to end homelessness. Invite a speaker! Watch a movie!
